ANGELS HC - 40th ANNIVERSARY

THIS year, 2003 marks the 40th anniversary of the foundation of the now world famous Angels HC. Founded by Jim Pollock in 1963 (sadly he died in 2001), the Angels was formed specifically for foreign touring, the first tour being to New York, Washington and Bermuda in 1963. Tours have been made to over 40 countries, with the early tours lasting a month, visiting four or five countries with a party of over 30, in a men's and women's team. Of note were visits to China, Outer Mongolia and Japan, and a round-the-world tour. In addition the Angels HC has hosted literally hundreds of teams from overseas visiting the UK.

An anniversary dinner is being held on 10th May 2003, and all who have been involved with the Angels are invited to attend, or submit "memories and pictures" for publication at the event.
